Sub: De-allocation and deduction of Bank Guarantee of North Dhadu coal block in the State of Jharkhand allocated to M/s Electrosteel Casting Limited, M/s Adhunik Alloys & Power Limited, M/s Jharkahnd Ispat Pvt. Limited and M/s Pawanjay Steel & Power Limited - Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's allocation letter No. 13016/31/2005-CA-I dated 13th January, 2006 (Annexure-I) and to this Ministry's show cause notice No. 13011/29/2012-CA-I dated 3rd May, 2012 (Annexure-II) and to your reply to the show cause notice, your presentation made/documents submitted before the Inter Ministerial Group (IMG) in respect of North Dhadu coal block and the status note on the development of the block prepared by Coal Controller and Ministry of Coal on the above subject.

2. North Dhadu coal block located in the State of Jharkhand was allocated to M/s, Electrosteel Casting Limited (ESCL), M/s Adhunik Alloys & Power Limited (AAP), M/s Jharkhand Ispat Pvt, Limited (JIPL) and M/s Pawanjay Steel & Power Limited (PSPL) under the Section 3(3)(a)(iii) of the Coal Mines (Nationalization) Act, 1973 for working through a joint venture company to meet the coal requirement of 120 mt, 43 mt, 49 mt and 33 mt of M/s ESCL,

AAP, JIPL and PSPL respectively for use in their plants for sponge iron production and captive power generation. This allocation is in pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 3 (3) (a) (iii) of the Coal Miners (Nationalisation) Act, 1973 and as per Option-I, and subject to certain terms and conditions.

In the allocation letter, One of the conditions of allocation was that coal production from the captive block shall commence within 36 months (42 months in case the area is in forest land) in case of open cast mine and in 48 months (54 months in case the area falls under forest land) in case of UG mine from the date of allocation letter. The end- use project schedule and the coal mine development schedule should be modified accordingly and submitted to the Ministry within 3 months from the date of allocation and one of other important conditions that allocation/mining lease of the coal block may be cancelled, inter-alia, on the following grounds:-

- (a) Unsatisfactory progress of implementation of their end use sponge iron plant/power plant.
- (b) Unsatisfactory progress in the development of coal mining projects.
- (e) For breach of any of the conditions of allocation.

The De-allocation/ cancellation of mining lease shall be without any liability to the Govt. or its agencies, whatsoever. Any expenses incurred by the allocate or any right or liability arising on the allocateess out of the measures taken by him shall solely be to his account and in no way be transferred to or borne by the Govt. or its agencies.

- 3. The progress of allocated coal block as well as linked/associated end use project has been reviewed by the Ministry through Review Committee from time to time wherein the allocatee company give presentation in respect of the development made by the company with reference to the milestones prescribed in the allocation letter during which it was noted as following:
- i) Review meeting held on 15/16.10.2008, all activities including GR, Bank Guarantee, Mining Lease and Mining Plan submission etc. are pending. No significant progress after last review meeting. No representative attending the meeting.
- ii) Review meeting held on 22/23.06.2009 JVC formed. All other milestones are pending. FC, ML application already made. As regards EUP, it was stated that their 30 MW power plant will come by August, 2009. Coal washery has been set up. It was informed by M/s Adhunik Alloys and Power Limited that the coal reserve in the block is more than the requirement of their EUP and requested to correct the figure before submission of MP. At the stage, Chairman advised to furnish the MP first and not to raise this issue before submission of MP. The issue of coal reserve more than requirement will be settled separately. He further advised to submit the statement of activity to CCO early.
- iii) Review meeting held on 20/21.07.2010, Forest Clearance, EMP, Mining Plan, Mining Lease and Land Acquisition are pending. Fire clay areas involved in the block lease hold area. EUP details of Adhunik Alloys not being submitted by the JVC. Committee advised to settle the fire clay issue in ML holds area with the State Govt. Secretary (Mines), GoJH would facilitate. To submit status report in respect of EUP of Adhunik Alloys Limited to CCO. The committee was dissatisfied with the development of

mine and asked to issue show cause for de-allocation. Show cause notice was issued on 2nd pecember, 2010 for inordinate delay in development of the block.

- The Committee examined the replies on 28th January, 2011 and 4th February, 2011, submitted by the allocatees against the show cause notice issue to the allocatees vide letter dated 2nd December, 2010 and recommended deduction of Bank Guarantee.
- Review meeting held on 11/12.01.2012, Forest Clearance. EMP, Mining Lease, Land Acquisition are pending. ML application submitted. 220 acres land acquired. Modified / revised mining plan submitted to MOC in Oct, 2011. Forest clearance application submitted. Dump area problem is there. Approval of revised mining plan is the main issue. The company was issued the show cause notice. The company furnished their reply to the show cause notice.
- 4. In the meantime, the Government has set up an Inter-Ministerial Group (IMG) under the Chairpersonship of Additional Secretary (Coal), Ministry of Coal having members from Ministry of Power, Ministry of Steel, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of IPP, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Legal Affairs, Department of Economic Affairs. The IMG has been given the mandate to review the progress of development of allocated coal blocks and associated end use projects and to recommend action including de-allocation, if required. The case of the allocate company was referred to IMG. Accordingly, the IMG asked the allocatee company to make the Presentation before it on the progress of development of allocated coal blocks and associated end use project. The representatives of the allocatee company gave presentation on 19th September, 2012 before the IMG. The IMG considered the presentation, the status note of the North Dhadu coal block and associated EUP prepared by Ministry of Coal and Coal Controller's Organisation (Annexure-III). The progress of development of the block with reference to the milestones and their achievement is as under:-

5. After detailed deliberations, the IMG made its recommendation to de-allocate North Dhadu Coal block which was allocated to M/s Electrosteel Casting Limited, M/s Adhunik Alloys & Power Limited, M/s Jharlkhand Ispat Pvt. Limited and M/s Pawanjay Steel & Power Limited in its Eleventh meeting held on 19th September 2012. The recommendations made by the IMG are as follows:-

M/s Electrosteel Castings Limited, M/s Pawanjay Steel & Power Limited, M/s Jharkhand Ispat Pvt. Ltd., M/s Adhunik Alloys and Power Ltd. (North Dhadu)

The IMG considered the terms and conditions of allocation, the show cause notice issued, the reply and the presentation made by the company along with the latest status paper presented to the IMG. The IMG noted that 6 years and 8 months have elapsed from the date of allotment i.e. 13.1.2006. During the time given for making presentation, the allocate company did not make or submit any power point presentation and only made oral submission. IMG noted that the allocatees were required to form a JV within 30 days from the date of allotment but they formed the JV only on 22.10.2008. Consequently the company purchased the GR after a lapse of 2 years 10 months and submitted the BG after a lapse of 3

years from the date of allotment. The mining plan has been approved on 7.12.2010 after which other processes could have been initiated. Revised mining plan has also been approved in the meeting of the Standing Committee on 24.7.2012. The IMG noted that the first mining plan itself was submitted with a delay of 3 years and 4 months. EC and FC have not been obtained. Submission of application for the same has also been delayed. 435 acres of private land was stated to be in possession but supporting documents were not provided. The only letter produced before IMG showed that 208 ha, was in the name of M/s Electrosteel Castings Ltd. (but not in the name of JV which has to develop the coal block). CA certificates in support of investment made in the coal block were not submitted by the JV company. There are 4 enduse plants linked to the block. The end-use plants of M/s Adhunik Alloys & Power Ltd. and Jharkhand Ispat Pvt. Ltd. were stated to be in operation. The end-use plant of M/s Pawanjay Steel & Power Ltd. was reported to be in progress and that of M/s Electrosteel Castings Ltd, is still at proposal stage. CA certificate in support of investment has been provided only by M/s Adhunik Alloys & Power Ltd for Rs. 615.75 crores (from July, 2003 till March, 2012) reported on the end-use steel plant and by Jharkhand Ispat Pvt. Ltd. for Rs. 66.52 crores in their sponge iron and induction furnace division. During presentation, the company argued that the entire delay was not attributable to them and they assured that they will be in a position to open the mine in another 15 months. The IMG noted that the normative date of production is 13.7.2009.

Taking into account all factors and that there is no substantial progress in development of the coal block, though some investment has been made in some of the end-use plants, the IMG recommends that the coal block may be de-allocated with forfeiture of BG.

- 6. The recommendation of the IMG has since been considered and accepted by the Government. As the company has been given a number of opportunities to develop the coal block and the associated end use project and the allocatee company has failed to develop the same as per the milestones prescribed without any valid reasons for the delay, it has been decided to de-allocate the North Dhadu coal block in the State of Jharkhand allocated M/s Electrosteel Casting Limited, Kolkata; M/s Adhunik Alloys & Power Limited, Jamshedpur; M/s Jharkhand Ispat Pvt. Limited, Jharkhand; and M/s Pawanjay Steel & Power Limited, Rourkela. In addition, it is further recommended by IMG the Bank Guarantee in complete is also forfeited (Rs. 56.03 crores). The company shall not be eligible for allocation of any alternative coal block in lieu of the de-allocated coal block.
- M/s Electrosteel Castings Ltd. Has filed W.P. (C) 6272/2012 in the Hon 'ble High Court
 of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court has passed the following order on 01.01.2012;

'In a connected Writ Petiton being W.P. (C) 5877/2012, I had passed the following order

"... After some arguments, Mr Sorabjee, learned senior counsel, on instructions seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to approach this Court in case an order adverse to the interest of the petitioner is passed. He further prays that if any adverse order is passed, the same may not be given effect to for a short period of time.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. In case an adverse order is passed, the same will not be given effect for a period of one week..."

Mr Singhvi, learned senior counsel, says that he is seeking the same directions as passed in WP (C) 5877/2012. Accordingly, the captioned writ petition is disposed of in terms of directions contained in WP (C) 5877/2012.

In compliance of the above order, this order is made effective after a period of one week from the date of issue.

I am directed to refer to the request of M/s. Electrosteel Castings Ltd., M/s. Adhunik Alloys & Power Ltd., M/s. Jharkhand Ispat Ltd. and M/s. Pawanjay Steel & Power Ltd., for allocation of coal blocks in the CCL area and to state that the requests of these companies have been considered by the Central Government and it has been decided to allot the coal block of North Dhadu jointly to M/s. Electrosteel Castings Ltd., (ESCL), M/s. Adhunik Alloys & Power Ltd. (AAPL), M/s. Jharkhand Ispat Pvi. Ltd. (IPL) and M/s. Pawanjay Steel & Power Ltd., for working through a joint venture (IPL) and M/s. Pawanjay Steel & Power Ltd., for working through a joint venture company to meet the coal requirement of 120 mt., 43 mt., 49 mt. and 33 mt. of M/s ESCL, AAP, JIPL and PSPL respectively for use in their plants for sponge iron production and captive power generation. This allocation is in pursuance of the production and captive power generation. This allocation is in pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 3(3)(a)(iii) of the Coal Mines (Nationalization: Act, 1973 and as per option-1, and is subject to the following conditions:

A joint venture company be formed between ESCL, AAP, JIPL end PSPL. The equity holding in the joint venture company will be in proportion to the assessed coal requirement of the companies

- ii) M/s ESCL, AAP, JIPL and PSPL shall submit a joint venture agreement to the Ministry of Coal within 50 days from the date of issuance of the letter.
- The joint venture company shall be formed and registered by the allocatees within 60 days from the date of this allocation of this letter.
- The mining lease shall be obtained in the name of the Joint Venture Company and coal extracted from the mine shall be distributed among the allocated companies in the proportion of their assessed requirement. Any surplus coal overall or individually shall be handed over to CCL at transfer price to be delivered by the Central Government.
- The block is meant for captive use in the specified end use projects of M/s. ESCL, AAP, JIPL and PSPL.
- Middlings generated in the process of washing the coal shall be used for power generation in their own power plant i.e., the useable middlings/rejects generated during beneficiation shall be used captively by the allocatees. The modalities of disposal of surplus coal/middlings/rejects, if any, would be as per the prevailing policy/instruction of the government at the relevant point in time and could also include handing over such surplus coal/middling/rejects to the local CIL subsidiary or to any person designated by it at a transfer price to be determined by the Government
- vii) Coal production from the captive block shall commence within 36 months (42 months in case the area is in forest land) in case of open cast mine and in 48 months (54 months in case the area falls under forest land) from the date of this letter in case of UG mine. The end-use project schedule and the coal mine development schedule should be modified accordingly and submitted to the Ministry within 3 months from the date of this letter (copy of milestone chart is enclosed).
- Viii) The company shall buy geological report from CMPDIL within six weeks of the date of this letter.

- The Joint venture company of M/s. ESCL. AAP, JIPL and PSPL shall submit a bank guarantee for Rs. 56.03 crores (equal to one year's royalty amount) based on mine capacity of 8.15 mips assessed by CMPDIL, grades of coal from C to G grades and the weighted average royalty @ Rs. 68.75 per tonne) within three months of the date of this letter. Subsequently, upon approval of mining plan the Bank Guarantee amount will be modified based on the final peak rated capacity of the mine.
- The company shall submit a mining plan for approval by the competent authority under the Central Government within six months from the date of the lotter.

The progress of the mine will be monitored annually with respect to the approved mining plan, which will mention the zero date. In case of any lag in the production of coal, a percentage of the bank guarantee amount will be deducted for the year. Any expenses incurred by the allocatees or any Government or its agencies, whatsoever any expenses incurred by the allocatees or any right or liability arising on the allocatees out of the measures taken by them shall solely right or liability arising on the way be transferred to or borne by the Government or its be to their account and in no way be transferred to or borne by the Government or its agencies.

3. The company Joint vanture of M/s ESCL, AAP, JiPL & PSPL may approach CMPDIL for the geological report and contact the State Government authorities

concerned for the necessary permissions/clearances etc. for attaining mining rights and related matters. The arrangement of transport of coal will have to be worked out by the company.

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No.13016/31/2005-CA-I dated 13.01.2006 conveying allocation of North Dhadu coal block in pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 3(3)(a) of the Coal Mines (Nationalization) Act, 1973, subject to certain conditions. One of the conditions of allocation was that coal production from the captive block shall commence within 36 months (42 months in case the area is in forest land) in case of open cast mine and in 48 months (54 months in case the area falls under forest land) in case of UG mine from the date of allocation letter. The end- use project schedule and the coal mine development schedule should be modified accordingly and submitted to the Ministry within 3 months from the date of allocation.



2. In order to expedite the development of the coal block, various review meetings were held from time to time with the representatives of the company. In the review meeting held on 11/12.01.2012, it was noticed that no serious efforts have been made by the company to develop the coal block, even after repeated assurances tendered by the Company during the period. It is also noted that all the important/critical milestones such as grant of previous approval, Mining Lease, Forest Clearance and Land Acquisition are pending for North Dhadu coal block. The company has repeatedly failed to keep its promises made to the Ministry and is thus non-serious about timely development of the block. The details of milestones to be achieved and the time lapsed against each milestone are given in the table below:-

Under the above circumstances, you are hereby called upon to show cause, on each milestone separately, to this Ministry within a period of 20 days from the date of issue of the show cause notice as to why the delay in the development of the coal block should not be held as violation of the terms and conditions of the allotment of North Dhadu coal block, failing which it would be presumed that your company has no explanation to offer and action as appropriate would be taken against your company for de-allocation of North Dhadu coal block.
