Sub: Submission of Bank Guarantee (BG) in respect of Utkal-E coal block in the State of Orissa allotted to M/s National Aluminum Company Limited (NALCO) - Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's allocation letter No.47011/7(60)/93-CPA/CPAM/CA dated 27th August, 2004 (Annexure-I) and to this Ministry's show cause notice letter No. 13011/17/2012-CA-I dated 2nd May, 2012 (Annexure-II) and to your reply to the show cause notice and the Presentation made/documents submitted by you on 10th October, 2012 before the Inter Ministerial Group (IMG) on the above subject.

- 2. Utkal-E coal block located in the State of Orissa was allocated to M/s National Aluminum Company Limited (NALCO) in pursuance of the Section 3(3)(a)(iii) of the Coal Mines (Nationalisation) Act, 1973 subject to certain terms and conditions. In the allocation letter, at point No.(v) the following is stipulated as under:-
- "(v) Allocation of coal block may be cancelled in case of unsatisfactory progress in implementation of their proposed end use projects or coal mining project or both."
- 3. The progress of allocated coal block has been reviewed by the Ministry through a Review Committee from time wherein the allocatee company give presentation in respect of the development made by them with reference to the milestones prescribed in the allocation letter during which it was noted as following:
 - i. In the review meeting held on 25/26.03.2008 it was noticed that the company has taken the possession of Government land and private land had not yet been acquired. FC Stage-I was expected in October, 2008. OB removal to start in December, 2008.
 - ii. In the Review Meeting held on 15/16.10.2008, it was noted that only government land was in possession and private land had not yet been acquired.

FS Stage-I expected in October, 2008. OB removal to start in December, 2008. No representative was in the meeting.

- iii. Further, the Review Committee in its meeting held in 22/23.06.2009 it was noted that Block was unexplored and GR was available in 4/05, FC, EMP, ML execution and land Acquisition were pending. Due to boundary dispute, revised ML submitted, EMP and LA are expected soon. No representative attended the meeting. Chairman viewed it seriously and urged to bring this to the notice of NALCO Authority/ Ministry of Mines. He further advised to monitor the block intensively so that the mine can come up early.
- iv. In the Review Committee meeting held on 20/22.07.2010 it was noted that Block was unexplored and GR was available in 4.05. FC, EMP, ML execution and Land Acquisition pending. Due to boundary dispute, revised ML submitted, EMP & LA are expected soon. The company was asked to submit time schedule within 2 months i.e action plan with dates. The committee viewed it seriously and urged to bring this to the notice of NALCO Authority. If the company does not respond within 2 months, show cause notice for de-allocation to be issued.
- v. The Review Committee meeting held on 11/12.01.2012 it was noticed that FC(Stage-I), ML, LA are pending. Company stated that 98.4 crores have been spent. Required amount for 526 HA for private land paid to Government of Odisha. 169 Ha forest land acquired. The company was issued the show cause notice. The company furnished their reply to the show cause notice.
- 4. In the meantime, the Government has set up an Inter-Ministerial Group (IMG) under the Chairpersonship of Additional Secretary (Coal), Ministry of Coal having members from Ministry of Power, Ministry of Steel, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of IPP, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Legal Affairs, Department of Economic Affairs. The IMG has been given the mandate to review the progress of development of allocated coal blocks and associated end use projects and to recommend action including de-allocation, if required.
- 5. The case of the allocate company was referred to IMG. Accordingly, the IMG asked the allocatee company to make the Presentation before it on the progress of development of allocated coal blocks and associated end use project. The representatives of the allocatee company gave presentation on 10th October, 2012 before the IMG. The IMG considered the presentation, the status note of the Utkal-E coal block and associated EUP prepared by Ministry of Coal and Coal Controller's Organisation (Annexure-III). The progress of development of the block with reference to the milestones and their achievement is as under:-

6. After detailed deliberations, the IMG made its recommendation as follows:

M/s NALCO (Utkal-E)

The IMG considered the terms and conditions of allocation, the show cause notice issued and the reply along with the presentation made by the allocatee and the status paper placed before the IMG. The IMG noted that this is a fully explored block and more than 8 years have elapsed from the date of allotment i.e. 27.8.2004. The allocatee M/s NALCO had applied for the block for its proposed 9,10,11,12 CPP units at Angul, Orissa in which an investment of Rs.1026.62 crores was reported. A further amount of Rs.114.53 crores has been spent on the coal block as per the CA certificate submitted by the allocatee. The allocatee company has obtained EMP clearance and application for land acquisition has been made. The land cost of four villages has been deposited with IDCO. The sections 4(1) and 6(1) notifications have been completed. The normative date for start of production was 27.2,2008.

Taking into account all factors, including substantial progress and investment, the IMG did not consider it appropriate to recommend de-allocation of the coal block at this stage. However, in view of the slippage in milestones, IMG recommends that the allocatee may be permitted to continue holding the block only on submission of BG equivalent to one year royalty for adherence to milestones. IMG further recommends that the BG may be submitted within a period of three months from the date of issue of letter in this regard failing which the block may be deallocated.

- 7. The recommendation of the IMG has since been considered and accepted by the Government.
- 8 Accordingly, M/s NALCO is directed to furnish a Bank Guarantee (BG) of Rs. 17.92 Crore (Rupees Seventeen crores Ninety two lakes only), be submitted to the Coal Controller's Organisation within a period of three months from the date of



issue of this letter failing which the block may be de-allocated. The BG amount as calculated by the Coal Controller's Organisation is at Annexure –IV.

Sir.

I am directed to refer to your letters dated 25.8.99, 9.3.2000, 2.5.2000, 13.9.2001, 16.1.2002, 2.7.2002 and 9.6.2003 for allocation of Utkal 'E' captive coal block to meet the coal requirement for the proposed 9,10,11,12 CPP units at Angul, Orissa and to say that your proposal was considered in the 21st meeting of the Screening Committee held on 19.8.2003. The Screening Committee, after deliberating the issue, decided to allocate Utkal 'E' block to the company provisionally for prospecting in the block to be done by CMPDIL on payment basis by NALCO. The block has since been prospected in details by CMPDIL. As per the information of CMPDIL out of the geological reserve of 154.45 million tonnes, 84.70 million tonnes of coal reserves has been assessed by CMPDIL as extractable reserves by opencast mining. Therefore, the extractable reserve approximately matches with the coal requirement of 90.6 million tonnes for power generation by NALCO and therefore, the Utkal 'E' coal block has been decided for allocation to NALCO. The allocation of Utkal 'E' coal block is subject to the following conditions:-

- i) All coal mined from this block shall exclusively be used by the company to meet the requirement of the proposed 9,10,11,12 captive power plant units.
- ii) The setting up of the proposed CPP (9,10 units) has been indicated from July, 2004 to February, 2008.
- There should be complete synchronization between the captive coal mining operations and the development of end-use (power generation) plants that no situation arises where the company is left with coal extracted from the captive block when the end-use plant is yet to be operational.
- The coal mining will be done in accordance with the provisions of Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 and Mineral Concession Rules.

 1960 and subject to the provisions of other relevant statutes.



- v) Allocation of coal block may be cancelled in case of unsatisfactory progress in implementation of their proposed end use projects or coal mining project or both.
- 3. The allocation of the captive block will also be subject to the following conditions:-
- All the conditions imposed by the Central Government while conveying the previous approval to the State Government under Section 5(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 for grant of mining lease in favour of captive mining party should clearly form part of the lease deed to be executed between the concerned State Government and the party.
- In case the captive block has been offered for washing-cum-end use, the mining lease deed must clearly specify that the beneficiated coal from the washery will exclusively be used for the end use (power generation) as approved by the Central Government and not for commerce or otherwise. Tailings, middlings or rejects, as the case may be, shall be used for captive consumption only by the applicant as approved by the Central Government.
- The allocattee would furnish to this Department detailed plan for disposal of unusable containing carbon materials obtained during the process of mining or any process thereafter including washing etc. so as to avoid any need for disposal of the same through sale etc. at a later stage, within 30 days of receipt of this letter or submission of mining plan whichever is earlier.
- iv) No coal shall be sold, delivered, transferred or disposed of except for the stated captive mining purpose (power generation) except with the previous approval of the Central Government in writing.
- v) Approval of mining plan shall be considered only after financial closure for the end use project is achieved.
- vi) Existing coal linkage from CIL/SCCL, would not be disturbed in any way with the coal mined from the allocated blocks. The coal linkage of 2.5 mtpa provided for the TPSs from MCL shall continue.
- vii) NALCO shall obtain geological report from CMPDIL on payment of the full cost of the geological report.
- viii) Violation of any of the conditions will render the allocation of the block/ grant of the lease as the case may be liable for cancellation.
- 4. The progress in this regard should be reported to this Department every 3 months from now.



5. The company may approach CMPDIL for the geological report etc. and contact the State Government authorities concerned for completing the necessary formalities for attaining mining lease rights and related matters. The company will be required to apply for mining lease within a period of six months. The arrangement of transport of coal, if any, etc. will have to be worked out by the company in consultation with the Ministry of Railways / Ministry of Surface Transport depending on the mode of transport.

Sir.

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No.47011/7(60)/93-CPA/CPAM/CA dated 27.08.2004 conveying allocation of Utkal-E coal block in pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 3(3)(a) of the Coal Mines (Nationalization) Act, 1973, subject to certain conditions. One of the conditions of allocation was that coal production from the captive block shall commence within 36 months (42 months in case the area is in forest land) in case of open cast mine and in 48 months (54 months in case the area falls under forest land) in case of UG mine from the date of allocation letter. The enduse project schedule and the coal mine development schedule should be modified accordingly and submitted to the Ministry within 3 months from the date of allocation.

2. In order to expedite the development of the coal block, various review meetings were held from time to time with the representatives of the company. In the review meeting held on 11/12.01.2012, it was noticed that no serious efforts have been made by the company to develop the coal block, even after repeated assurances tendered by the Company during the period. It is also noted that all the important/critical milestones such as Forest Clearance, Mining Lease and land acquisition are pending for Utkal -E coal block. The company has repeatedly failed to keep its promises made to the



Ministry and is thus non-serious about timely development of the block. The details of milestones to be achieved and the time lapsed against each milestone are given in the table below:-
