Subject: Show Cause Notice to M/s. Karanpura Energy Limited in respect of Mourya (OC) coal block - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. 13016/19/2007-CA-I dated 26th June, 2009 conveying 'in-principle' approval of the Central Government to the working of Mourya (OC) coal block in South Karanpura coalfields of Central Coalfields Limited to be set up by M/s Karanpura Energy Limited, an SPV of Jharkhand State Electricity Board (JSEB) under the tariff based competitive bidding route subject to certain condition.

- 2. In order to expedite the development of the coal block, review meetings were held from time to time. In the review meeting held on 11/12.01.2012, it was noticed that the progress of the Mourya OC coal block allocated to the company was not satisfactory but it was seen that these blocks were delayed due to 'Go/NO Go' categorization, location of wildlife corridors, allocation to PFC for UMPPs and overlapping of coal bearing area with CBM/Aerotropolis project. The Committee expressed concern over unsatisfactory progress and advised M/s Karanpura Energy Limited to expedite the development of the coal block. Accordingly, an advisory letter dated 26th April, 2012 was issued to the company with the direction to expedite the development of the coal block and development of end use plant so as to ensure expeditious production of coal from the allotted coal block with respect to the milestones stipulated.
- 3. In the meantime, the Government constituted an Inter-Ministerial Group (IMG) on 21.06.2012 under the Chairpersonship of Additional Secretary (Coal), Ministry of Coal having members from Ministry of Power, Ministry of Steel, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of IPP, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Legal Affairs, Department of Economic Affairs. The IMG given the mandate to review the progress of development of allocated coal blocks and associated end use projects and to recommend action including de-allocation, if required. IMG in its 19th Meeting held on 25.06.2013 inter alia considered the

status of the development of the Mourya OC coal block prepared by the Coal Controller's Organisation (CCO) as on March, 2013 and noted that no significant progress has been made by your company towards development of coal block. It has been noticed that a number of important/critical milestones are pending. The details of milestones to be achieved and the time lapsed against each milestone, as reported by the Office of Coal Controller, are given in the table below:

- 3. Keeping in view the unsatisfactory progress, IMG recommended to issue show cause notice for delay in development of coal block. The recommendation of IMG has since been considered and accepted by the Government.
- 4. Under the above circumstances, you are hereby called upon to show cause, on each milestone separately to this Ministry within a period of **20 days** from the date of issue of this show cause notice as to why the delay in the development of the coal block should not be held as violation of the terms and conditions of the allocation of Mourya (OC) coal block and why the block should not be deallocated failing which it would be presumed that the your company has no explanation to offer and action as appropriate would be taken against your company for de-allocation of the said coal block.
- 5. You are also requested to furnish a detailed status note on the progress of end use plant(s) (EUPs) for which the above mentioned coal block was allocated to you.
