S.O. Whereas by the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Coal number S.O. ______ dated ______ issued under sub-section (1) of section-4 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition & Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), and published in the Gazette of India part-II, section-3, sub-section (ii) dated ______, the Central Government gave notice of its intention to prospect for coal in ______ hectares (approximately) or ______ acres (approximately) of the lands in the locality specified in the Schedule annexed to that notification ;

And whereas the Central Government is satisfied that coal is obtainable in a part of the said lands prescribed in the Schedule(s) appended to this notification.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 7 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby gives notice of its intention to acquire the land measuring _____hectares (approximately) or _____acres (approximately) and all rights in or over the said lands described in the schedule appended hereto;

Note 1. The Plan bearing NO. _____ dated _____ of the area covered by this notification may be inspected in the office of the Collector, _____ or in the office of the Coal Controller, 1, Council House Street, Kolkata 700001, or in the office of the _____

Note 2. Attention is hereby invited to the provisions of section 8 of the said Act which provides as follows:-

Objection to acquisition

8 (1) Any person interested in any land in respect of which a notification under section 7 has been issued, may, within thirty days of the issue of the notification, object to the acquisition of the whole or any part of the land or any rights in or over such land.

Explanation:

(1) It shall not be an objection within the meaning of this section for any person to say that he himself desires to undertake mining operation in the land for the production of coal and that such operations should not be undertaken by the Central Government or by any other person.

(2) Every objection under sub section (1) shall be made to the competent authority in writing, and the competent authority shall give the objector an opportunity of being heard either in person or by a legal practitioner and shall, after hearing all such objections and after making such further inquiry, if any, as he thinks necessary, either make a report in respect of the land which has been notified under sub-section (1) of section 7 or of rights in or over such land, or make different reports in respect of different parcels of such land or of rights in or over such land, to the Central Government, containing his recommendations on the objections, together with the record of the proceedings held by him, the decision of that Government.

(3) For the purposes of this section, a person shall be deemed to be interested in land who would be entitled to claim an interest in compensation if the land or any rights in or over such land were acquired under this Act.

Note 3. The Coal Controller, 1 Council House Street, Kolkata 700001 has been appointed by the Central Government as the competent authority under section 3 of the said Act, vide notification number SO_____, dated the _____, published in part II, section 3, sub-section (ii) of the Gazette of India dated the _____.
