In order to commemorate the day of adoption of our constitution, the occasion of Samvidhan Diwas (Constitution Day) is also being organized with “Jan Bhagidari” on a mega scale.

2 Hon’ble President of India will be leading the celebrations of Constitution Day live from Central Hall of Parliament on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 from 11.00 hours onwards. The occasion will be graced by Hon’ble Vice-President, Hon’ble Prime Minister, Hon’ble Speaker, Ministers, MPs and other dignitaries and the whole of India will be a part of these celebrations through live streaming of the function on Sansad TV/DD/Other TV Channels and Online portals.

3 In view of the above and considering Covid-19 pandemic, it has been decided that Additional Secretary (Coal) and officers of the level JS and above will join in the reading of preamble on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 at 11.00 am in the Conference Room, MoC along with Hon’ble President of India. Whereas other Officers/Officials of MoC is requested to join the Hon’ble President in reading of the Preamble at 11 AM on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 from their respective rooms and Sections. It is also requested to visit the following two portals being developed by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs:-

1. Portal for reading Preamble to the Constitution in 23 languages (22 official languages and English)(<https://readpreamble.nic.in>)


2. Portal for “Online Quiz on Constitutional Democracy” (<https://constitutionquiz.nic.in>)

(These portals will be accessible to everybody and anyone can participate and get certificates. These portals may be given wide publicity)


4. In this connection all concerned are also requested to kindly to ensure that guidelines issued in the wake of COVID 19 pandemic are adhered to.

## PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

WE DO HEREBY GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
